## 2019 SCFD - OPERATIONAL PERMIT FEES

Operational Permit fees are required for the following occupancies which are more hazardous than others, or require more time for the SCFD to monitor or inspect. (IFC Section 105.6)

<b>Aerosol Products</b>	
An operational permit is required to manufacture, store or handle an aggregate quantity of Level 2 or Level 3 aerosol products in excess of 500 pounds (227 kg) net weight.	\$75.00 <b>Annually</b>
<b>Amusement buildings</b>	
An operational permit is required to operate a special amusement building.	<b>See Places of Assembly</b>
<b>Battery Systems</b>	
To maintain lead acid, Lithium all types, Nickel Cadmium, sodium, flow battery systems and VRLA battery systems > 20kWh - < 600kWh.	\$100.00 <b>Annually</b>
To maintain lead acid, Lithium all types, Nickel Cadmium, sodium, flow battery systems and VRLA battery systems => 600kWh (H2 Occupancy).	\$1,000.00 <b>Annually</b>
<b>Bowling Pin or Alley Refinishing</b>	
Bowling Pin refinishing or bowling alley resurfacing operation involving the use of flammable liquids or materials.	\$100.00 <b>Permit</b>
<b>Carnivals and fairs</b>	
An operational permit is required to conduct a carnival or fair.	
Per Event	\$200.00 <b>Permit</b>
Amusement Building	\$200.00 <b>Permit</b>
Indoor Trade Show (< 5,000 sq.ft.)	\$150.00 <b>Permit</b>
Indoor Trade Show (> 5,000 sq.ft.)	\$250.00 <b>Permit</b>
Indoor Display of liquid or gas-fueled vehicles	\$150.00 <b>Permit</b>
<b>Combustible dust-producing operations</b>	
An operational permit is required to operate a grain elevator, flour starch mill, feed mill, or a plant pulverizing aluminum, coal, cocoa, magnesium, spices or sugar, or other operations producing combustible dusts as defined in Chapter 2.	\$150.00 <b>Annually</b>
<b>Compressed gases.</b> An Operational Permit is required for:	
Store, use or handle at normal temperatures and pressures compressed gases > exempt amounts	\$75.00 <b>Annually</b>
Compressed Gas system installation or asphyxiant liquid storage system - includes cylinders and all piping, valves and related equipment < 400 lbs.	\$250.00 <b>Permit</b>
Compressed Gas system installation or asphyxiant liquid storage system - includes cylinders and all piping, valves and related equipment > 400 lbs.	\$350.00 <b>Permit</b>
CO-2 or other asphyxiant compressed gas or liquid storage system	\$100.00 <b>Annually</b>
Compressed Gas system modification - <i>if work involves more than 50% of the system, the fees for a new installation shall apply.</i>	\$75.00 <b>Permit</b>
<b>Contractor Application</b>	<b>\$75.00 Annually</b>
<b>Covered and open mall buildings</b> An operational permit is required for:	
1. The placement of retail fixtures and displays, concession equipment, displays of highly combustible goods and similar items in the mall.	\$250.00 <b>Permit</b>
2. The display of liquid- or gas-fired equipment in the mall.	\$250.00 <b>Permit</b>
3. The use of open-flame or flame-producing equipment in the mall.	\$250.00 <b>Permit</b>
<b>Cryogenic fluids</b>	
1. Installation	Install of Cryogenics system \$400.00 <b>Permit</b>
2. Produce, store, transport on site, use, handle or dispense <i>cryogenic fluids</i> in excess of the amounts listed in Table 105.6.10.	Store, transport on site, dispense, or use > exempt amts. \$150.00 <b>Permit</b>
<b>Cutting and welding</b>	
An operational permit is required to conduct cutting or welding operations within the jurisdiction.	\$100.00 <b>Permit</b>
