The Sun City Fire & Medical Department is part of metropolitan Phoenix area consortium of fire departments that include Phoenix, Glendale, Peoria, Tempe, Tolleson, Laveen and Daisy Mountain. Our three fire stations are geographically distributed throughout our community and the Sun City Fire & Medical Department run in excess of 14,000 calls annually.
